## AMENDED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE # 1 CHAPTER 21 SECTION 21.9 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ELTON, LOUISIANA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN AND MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF ELTON, IN REGULAR SESSION ON THE  $8^{TH}$  OF MARCH , 2021 AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. TO AMEND SECTION 21.19 ARTICLE C (DOGS) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ELTON TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

B) NO OTHER DOG SHALL BE DESTROYED UNTIL 5 DAYS HAVE ELAPASED SINCE THE DOG WAS IMPOUNDED AND NOT THEN UNLESS THE OWNER HAS NOT BEEN FOUND OR SOMEONE WHO WILL PAY THE CHARGES ABOVE STIPULATED AND ACCEPT THE DOG.

C) IF A PERSON WISHED TO PICK UP THEIR DOG, OR AN UNCLAIMED DOG AFTER 5 DAYS, THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO PAY \$25.00 PLUS \$10.00 PER DAY FOR HOLDING THE DOG. THEY MUST ALSO PAY FOR A RABIES SHOT BEFORE THE DOG IS RETURNED.

DOGS MAY BE PICKED UP MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY FROM 8AM TO 12 NOON AND FROM 1:00 PM TO 4PM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Mayor and the board of ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF ELTON, LOUISIANA THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME AND BE MADE A PART OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ELTON, LOUISIANA, AND THE SECTION OF THIS ORDINANCE MAY BE RENUMBERED TO ACCOMPLISH THIS INTENTION.

THE ABOVE ORDINANCE IS ADOPTED ON THE  $8^{\text{TH}}$  DAY OF MARCH .
