Gabriel Fontenot from local business HUNT is moving forward quickly and is now interested in manufacture of ammo and shotguns, possibly in either buildings, those present or a new one to be built; it will require a light-heavy manufacturing zoning and Town would need to look into zoning for it- may require a referendum of voters and possible Council land use ordinance
11. Police Report: Discussion on vehicles: Stated he did not think the units were in good shape and should give them to the JDSO
Council Kay Hebert questioned the insurance cancellation on units not being used



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Attorney Holmes stated the Town would need an 'inoperability affidavit' and the Chief will need to release the units from use to declare them as surplus for the Town to sell or donate

Resident Greg Davis asked what the liability for the Town was for removing the incorrect trailer on his property-this will be discussed when all paperwork is looked over again to ensure Town has the correct forms-Council Kay Hebert assured that signatures were gathered and state did approve the demo; question of when the land was sold came into play and discovered land was purchased in May of 2024, while permission to list for demo was given 2023; meeting with Mr. Davis, Mayor and Attorney to take place later to address this issue
